

iPad Mini4 Bluetooth Keyboard User Instructions

iPad Mini Bluetooth Keyboard Pairing

Step 1: Turn on the power toggle switch. First time under factory settings the [Bluetooth] indicator light will keep blinking to read for pairing.

Step 2: From second time the [Bluetooth] indicator light will blink for 3 seconds, then the light will go off. Press on the [connect] button, the Bluetooth indicator light will blink and the keyboard is now ready to be connected to iPad Mini4.

Step 3: Turn on and unlock your iPad Mini4. Click on the settings icon.

Step 4: From the settings menu, select item [General] to access [Bluetooth] setting. Click on [Bluetooth] to turn on the connection, iPad Mini4 will automatically search for you Bluetooth enabled device.



Step 5: When the Keyboard is detected by your iPad Mini4, it will show: "Bluetooth 3.0 keyboard", "Bluetooth keyboard" or "iPad Bluetooth keyboard" listed under My Devices.

Step 6: Enter the four digit pass code as displayed to you on the screen, then press [enter] on the keyboard.

Step 7: When wireless keyboard connection is successful, the Bluetooth indicator light will go off and you are now ready to use your keyboard.

Charging the keyboard

When the battery power is low, the charge indicator light will start blinking. This indicates that it is time to recharge the keyboard.

Step 1: Connect USB-B of the native USB power cable to the keyboard charging interface.

Step 2: Connect USB-A to the power adapter or computer's USB interface.

Step 3: The blue or red charge indicator light will stay on when the keyboard is charging. Once it has finished charging, the blue indicator light will turn off.

Screen Brightness Function

To brighten or dim the screen on the iPad Mini4, first press the Function "fn" , while holding down the button, press the  to brighten the screen, or the  to dim the screen, or the  to brighten the screen.

Energy Saving Sleep Mode

The keyboard will go into sleep mode when it has been inactive for 15 minutes. To activate from sleep mode, press any key located on the keyboard and wait 3 seconds. The keyboard will come back on and is ready to be use

Protection Shield

Make sure your hands are clean. First using the Wipes in the Green package , wipe the iPad Mini4 screen thoroughly, then using the wipe in the Pink package  dry off any wet remains. Make sure there are no dust specks. If you see any dust on the screen, use the sticker "dust-absorber"  and place

it over visible dust specks to remove them. Place on of the guide stickers on one side the screen protector and one on the other side, so you don't have to peel on the screen used your fingers. Peel off the backing of the screen protector and gently place it on to of the screen, using the small squeegee pressing firm, move the squeegee downward to remove any visible air bubbles to the screen protector stays secure on top of the iPad Mini4

Safety Caution

1. Keep item away from sharp objects.
2. Do not place heavy objects on top of the keyboard.
3. Do NOT Microwave!
4. Do NOT use force or distort the keyboard.
5. Keep away from oils, organic liquids, house hold cleaners and excessive moisture.
6. Clean silicone keyboard with damp cloth or alcohol pad.

Preservation

Turn off the power when you are not using the keyboard to save the battery life.

Troubleshooting

(A) Unable to Connect

1. Make sure the power switch is on.
2. Make sure the keyboard is within the operating distance.
3. Make sure the keyboard is within the operation distance.
4. Make sure the Bluetooth setting on the iPad is switched to "On"
5. Make sure the wireless keyboard has been properly paired with the iPad.

(B) Unable to Charge Keyboard

1. Make sure the USB power cable is connected properly to the keyboard and the power source.
2. Make sure the wall charger is plugged into the power outlet.
